This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or directions to official respondents No.1 to 3, especially, in the nature of mandamus to protect the life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

On 05.11.2024, following order was passed:

“ In compliance of the previous order, Mr. Pardeep Singh, PPS, DSP, Sub-Division Phul, District Bathinda has put in appearance in the Court.

Learned State counsel has filed the reply dated 28.10.2024 by way of affidavit of above named appearing DSP on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record. Copy has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioners.



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In the reply it is mentioned that petitioner Babli gave her statement that now there is no threat to her life and liberty.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners confronts the said statement and wants to get instructions.

On request, adjourned to 11.11.2024.”

Today when the matter was called, learned State counsel has presented a copy of the statement of petitioner- Babli in the Court. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have now no threat perceptions and they seek to withdraw the present petition.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
