Present application has been filed for revival of the main writ petition i.e. CWP No.18079 of 2023.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioners submits that at the time when the writ petition was argued, the Court was not informed that the petitioners are claiming that they should only be asked to do the duties for the specified working hours hence, the same could not be decided and therefore, the order dated 19.08.2023 be recalled.

raises no objection for the grant of prayer as raised in the present application.
