The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

Petitioners submit that they have already submitted a representation dated 20.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon and they shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 20.07.2024 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

I have heard the petitioners and perused the file.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2—
The Senior Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the representation (Annexure P-1) and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on

the validity of the marriage of the parties. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.

With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
