1. This is the petitioner’s fourth attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.02 dated 01.01.2020, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa, Haryana.
2. The learned Senior counsel representing the petitioner fairly admits that the prosecution evidence has already been recorded and now the case is at the stage of defence evidence.
