1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking directions to respondent-department to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with their juniors in view of notification dated 22.08.2019 (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that his grievance at this stage would be redressed, if respondents are directed to decide his legal notice dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and fairly submits that Competent Authority would look into the representation of the petitioner and pass an order within 6 weeks from today.

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5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to decide legal notice dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously and preferably within 6 weeks from today.
