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**RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)**

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for quashing the impugned notices dated 02.08.2019 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) issued by respondents No.4 and 5 for convening the meeting of Municipal Committee Mahendergarh, illegally, unlawfully and contrary to the Haryana Municipal Business Bye Laws, 1981 and also on the grounds mentioned in the petition. Further prayer has been made for quashing the impugned order dated 26.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3 whereby the resolution No.1 dated 05.06.2019 passed by the

Municipal Committee, Mahendergarh with regard to sanction of budget for the year 2019-2020 has been ordered to be suspended and consequently, ordered to withdraw the approval letters No.922/LFA dated 26.06.2019 and for directing the respondents to convene the meeting of the M.C. Mahendergarh after issuing notice to all the working members of the Committee, including the petitioner and by following the bye laws in this regard and the subsequent proceedings in the meetings held by the M.C. Mahendergarh on 05.08.2019 & 08.08.2019 may kindly be stayed during the pendency of the present petition.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 has submitted that the meeting in question had already taken place and resolution already stands approved. He further submits that the tenure of the Municipal Committee is also over thus, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition and the same may be dismissed as such.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail her alternative remedy as available to her in accordance with law.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
