1. On 18.01.2024, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioner through instant petition is assailing show cause notice issued by the passport authority whereby petitioner was called upon to show cause as to why his passport should not be impounded.

Mr. Karan Kumar Jund, Senior Panel Counsel for Union of India-respondent submits that during the pendency of present petition, the passport authority has already suspended passport of the petitioner and he has not challenged the order of suspension. There is another development which has taken place during pendency of petition i.e. registration of FIR against the petitioner. CBI after completing investigation has filed its report under Section 173 Cr.P.C against the petitioner. The matter is pending before the Special Judge, CBI, Mohali.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks time to get instructions and address the arguments.
