In this way, petitioner and his family members have faced many such inquiries and this is the another attempt to mislead the authorities and also to harass the petitioner and his family members.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider and decide the representation dated 17.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) submitted by them in a time bound manner.

4. Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider and decide the representation dated 17.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
