**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 482 BNSS in case FIR No.130 dated 08.07.2024 under Sections 379-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

2. On the last date of hearing, i.e. 25.07.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation.

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents and a perusal of the FIR reveals that the only role attributed to him is of having snatched the crane along with*

*co-accused with whom there was some civil dispute pending.”*

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 25.07.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 25.07.2024 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./Section 482(2) BNSS. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
