AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

After detailed deliberations and assistance of the Insurance Company, we feel that the cross-objections filed by the respondent No.5-National Insurance Company are against the record. It appears to be an inadvertent omission on the part of the concerned persons. At this stage, learned counsel for the Insurance Company on instructions seeks to withdraw the cross-objections.

Cross-objections, XOBJC-27-CII-2013, dismissed as withdrawn.

The appeal stands settled at Rs.80,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of proposal form dated 30.09.2024 duly signed by both the parties.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant-Richi with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 14.11.2024. The amount be released in favour of the appellant-Richi as the learned counsel for the appellant does not press upon the issue of apportionment of the amount awarded as both the respondents have died.

Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
