MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Present criminal writ petition has been filed, under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No.1 to 6 to take action against private respondents on the basis of complaint(s) dated 23.08.2022 (P-8 & P-9).

2. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.

3. After hearing the parties for some time, when this Court was inclined to accept the prayer of petitioner, learned State counsel, on instructions, fairly submitted that her complaint dated 23.08.2022 (P-9) shall be inquired into by the senior officer viz. Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ropar and the proposal is acceptable to the petitioner as well.

4. Learned counsel for respondents No.7 to 9 has also not raised any objection in this regard.

5. In view of the aforesaid stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed off



with direction to Deputy Inspector General of Police, Ropar to inquire into the complaint dated 23.08.2022 (P-9) of the petitioner, in accordance with law, expeditiously.

6. Needless to say that in case either of the parties feel aggrieved against the report to be submitted by the DIG, Ropar, they would be at liberty to take recourse to the appropriate remedy available under law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
