- 1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for wilful disobedience of order dated 13.03.2023, passed by this Court in CWP 4848-2023.
- 2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has since been complied with and, as such, the present contempt petition may be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
- 3. In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
- 4. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
