1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the benefits in respect of service rendered by the wife of the petitioner have not been released to him after she had unfortunately died while in service on 30.06.1999.
2. The respondents have filed a short affidavit of Sunil Kumar, Principal, DDO of GSSS Selbrah, District Bathinda, wherein, it has been mentioned that the benefits have already been released to the petitioner and the details of the same have been mentioned in paragraph 2 of the reply.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in case, any of the benefit is yet to be release, liberty be given to the petitioner to file appropriate representation to claim the same and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.



4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be looked into in accordance with law and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
