VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 10.07.2018 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent no.1 exercising the power under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 whereby the petition for eviction of respondents no.2 and 3 from the self acquired house of the petitioner has partly been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well Amicus Curiae have jointly submitted that in the present case, the petitioner has died and thus, the present petition, in which the prayer for eviction was made, has been rendered infructuous.
