Learned counsel by way of the present application has sought disposal of the main case in terms of the order passed in **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others**, CWP-21645-2018, decided on 29.11.2021, which was disposed of with a direction to consider and decide the the legal notice, which he submits shall be served upon the respondents within a period of four weeks, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that he has no objection to the prayer made.

The main case is taken up on today’s Board and without commenting upon the merits thereof, the same is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioners submit a legal notice, it shall be decided within a period of four months from the date of its receipt, which this Court has no

reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner.
