1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the balance amount of gratuity i.e. Rs.5,05,050/- to the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of retirement till the date of its realization.
2. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last two consecutive dates. Today also the position is the same. It appears that the petitioner is not interested to further pursue the present case.
3. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
