By way of present petition filed under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent on account of alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 19.05.2023 (**Annexure P-3**) passed by this Court in CWP No. 10882 of 2023.

[2] Short reply by way of affidavit dated 11.09.2024 of Sh. Karnail Singh, Training Officer, NSTI Ludhiana, filed on behalf of the respondent, is taken on record. In view of the said reply, learned counsel for the respondent submits that the aforesaid order dated 19.05.2023 has been complied with, thereby rendering the present petition as infructuous.
