1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of a direction upon the official respondents not to harass the petitioners in case FIR No.107, dated 26.06.2024, under Section 394 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, and also to take action on their applications both dated 19.07.2024 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

2. Learned State counsel, who is on advance notice, caused appearance, and informs this Court, on instructions imparted to him by ASI Gurmeet Singh, that both the petitioners are not required in the instant FIR, so there is no question to cause any harassment to the present petitioners.

3. He further submits that in fact the son of the petitioner is involved not only in the instant FIR, but also in four other criminal cases and he is on run, and efforts are being made by the investigating agency to arrest him.
4. He next submits that the instant petition has been filed with an oblique motive to scuttle the ongoing investigation.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the specific statement suffered by learned State counsel, that petitioners are not required in the instant FIR, does not press for the instant petition.
6. **Dismissed as not pressed.**
