Challenge in the present petition is to the proceedings/order dated 26.07.2022 and 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-1) as well as against the subsequent proceedings done by respondents-National Commission for Scheduled Castes whereby the official respondents No. 2 to 5 have been directed to put respondent No. 7 in possession.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 7 contends that he has instructions to withdraw the complaint that was instituted before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes and that in view of such instructions, the consequential orders challenged herein may be set aside without prejudice to the rights of respondent No. 7 to pursue his substantive

right to seek possession in accordance with law.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No. 6-
National Commission for Scheduled Castes has no objection to the same.

Consequently, the present writ petition is disposed of as having
been rendered infructuous on the statement recorded by the counsel
appearing on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.7 withdrawing the
original complaint before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes
along with all consequential proceedings with liberty as aforesaid.
