1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner-in-person under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to appear in the ongoing interview process or to allow him to appear in the interview by extending the dates of interview with further prayer that the petitioner may be allowed to appear in the interview provisionally and one post of Computer Operator be kept vacant.

2. After issuance of notice of motion on 16.08.2019, the petitioner has never appeared on any date of hearing i.e. 20.08.2021, 20.12.2021, 09.03.2023 and even today also no one has put in appearance on his behalf.

3. In the reply filed by respondent No.4, it has been submitted in para 8 thereof that all the posts of Computer Operators advertised

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vide public notice dated 12.02.2019 have already been filled and all the successful candidates have already joined the service.

5. Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, therefore, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
