Upon notice of motion, the respondent have filed the reply. In the reply, the respondents have stated qua for the grant of 5 additional marks, keeping in view the directions given by this Court in CWP No. 1107 of 2011, the Instructions which provided for 5 marks to the candidate having rural background, have already been withdrawn. The further, the assertion of the respondents is that the petitioner was not entitled for marks for experience keeping in view of the fact that the petitioner had not worked on the post of Block Extension Educator.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the records of the present case with their able assistance.

In the present petition, the claim of the petitioner is that he has not been evaluated as per the criteria fixed by the respondents. The respondents are on record to say that the petitioner has been considered on the basis of the criteria which has been uniformly applied on all the candidates. As per the respondents, the Instructions that provided for the grant of 5 marks for the rural background has already been withdrawn and no candidate has been given the said benefit.

With regard to the grant of 10 marks for the experience, the petitioner has not worked on the post of Block Extension Educator but has worked on the post of Multi-purpose Health Worker and the marks for experience can only be given in case, a candidate has worked on the post on which, he/she is seeking consideration.

Merely that the Government Service has been rendered by a candidate, is not the criteria for the grant for marks for an experience. The respondents have granted the marks for experience only in case, a candidate

has experience against the relevant post for which he/she is competing for which is missing in the case of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above, no grievance can be made by the petitioner qua evaluation of his claim.

Hence, the present petition stands dismissed.

Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
