1. On 24.02.2024, following order was passed:-

“Learned senior counsel for the appellant submits that the registered letters sent on the address of the person earlier in touch with his office have returned undelivered, whereas the status with regard to the one sent at the address of appellant-company is yet to be verified. He seeks short accommodation for the same.

Accordingly, adjourned to 06.08.2024.”
