HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petitions, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner is not being given scribe to write the answers and this Court vide interim order dated 13.08.2019, allowed the said benefit.
2. During the Mains examination for HCS (Ex. Br.) and other Allied Services, it was found that scribe, which was allowed by this Court vide order dated 13.08.2019, was writing paper on his own without being dictated by the petitioner, which amounted to a case of unfair means.

Thereafter also, the petitioner did not appear for further exams and ultimately, the petitioner was debarred by the Commission vide order dated 03.09.2019 (Annexure R-2/1).

3. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner from the last three dates of hearing. Today again, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It can be safely presumed that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present writ petitions.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.

5. Any civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
