Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari seeking quashing of prejudicial part of the impugned order dated 13.01.2014 (Annexure P-6) which disturbs the parity granted over a period of 40 years in the matter of pay scales and allowances.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for claiming the relief in the present writ petition, petitioners shall submit a justice demand notice to the respondents within a period of six weeks, and the same may be considered in a time bound manner.

3. Counsel for the respondents has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners.

- 4. If the petitioners submit justice demand notice, within a period of six weeks, the same shall be considered and final decision be taken by the respondents, within a period of four months thereafter.
- 5. The petition stands disposed of.
- 6. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
