KIRTI SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is or grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.430 dated 14.06.2024, under Sections 420 and 465 IPC, registered at Ballabhgarh City, District Faridabad.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions from the Investigating Officer-SI Yashpal Singh of the concerned Police Station submits that in compliance of order dated 29.08.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
3. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed. Order dated 29.08.2024 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.
4. This order should not be treated as "blanket" order. It will not be read granting the petitioner indefinite protection from arrest. It shall be confined to the FIR mentioned *ibid* and will not operate in respect of any other incident that involves commission of an offence.



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5. This order does not in any manner limit or restrict the rights or duties of the police or investigating agency to investigate into the charges against the petitioner.
6. It will be open to the police or the investigating agency to move to this Court for a direction under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. to arrest the accused, in the event of violation of any term, such as absconding, non-cooperating during investigation, evasion, intimidation or inducement to witnesses with a view to influence outcome of the investigation or trial.
7. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
