SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

1. Instant petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside impugned order dated 24.08.2022, Annexure P-7, passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur, whereby an application dated 24.08.2022, Annexure P-6, filed by the petitioner for staying further proceedings, has been declined.

2. Pursuant to the previous order passed by this Court, report has been received from the learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur, relevant extract of which is reproduced as under:-



“Kindly refer to the subject cited above and in this regard it is submitted that present case has already been dismissed in default by the learned Predecessor of this court, when counsel for petitioner/applicant did not appear on 30.09.2022 and thereafter application was moved by petitioner for restoration of the same, in which respondent appeared and filed reply and now matter is fixed for arguments on the same.”

3. A perusal of the above report shows that the objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, filed by the petitioner, have been dismissed in default on account of non-appearance of the counsel. An application for restoration has been filed, which is pending.
4. In the above backdrop, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to take recourse to the remedy available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
