In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India, the grouse of the petitioner is that respondent No.2-Gram Panchayat, Kamalpur is wanting to seek possession by issuing notice under Section 24(1) of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994. It is the specific case of the petitioner that on an earlier occasion application under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 was decided in his favour and **CWP-4509-2010**(Annexure P-4/1) is pending before this Court.

2. It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioner that reply to the legal notice has also been sent on 17.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) and the said factum has been mentioned in the said reply.

3. Mr. Mago on instructions received from Mr. Narinder Sarwan, DDPO, Rewari submits that the said notice is not being acted upon by the Gram Panchayat.

4. In such circumstances, counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to press the present petition, since the State has conceded the claim as such.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of by binding the State to its undertaking.
