1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of inquiry proceedings which were initiated against him under Regulation 58 of Food Corporation of India (Staff) Regulations, 1971.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents pointing out short reply of Food Corporation of India submits that disciplinary authority after completing proceedings has already passed order of punishment dated 16.11.2018, thus, present petition has rendered infructuous.
3. From the perusal of record, it comes out that petitioner has assailed departmental proceedings pending prior to passing of punishment order. The respondent during the pendency of present petition has passed

punishment order dated 16.11.2018 and the petitioner has not assailed said order.

4. In the wake of development which has taken place during the pendency of petition, the present petition stands disposed of.
