1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.63 dated 13.06.2024, under Section 420 IPC and Section 66(c) of Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka. Further prayer has been made for staying the arrest of the petitioner.
2. Vide order dated 25.07.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 25.07.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ram Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.



5. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. In view of the above, interim order dated 25.07.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
7. Petition stands allowed.
