1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 17.03.2022 passed in CWP-6995-2020.
2. Affidavit of the respondent filed in the Registry, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 17.03.2022 passed in CWP-6995-2020 has since been complied with and the representation of the petitioners has been decided by passing the speaking orders dated 06.05.2022 and 02.01.2023 (Annexures R-1 and R-2, respectively).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
