The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners which is endangered at the hands of respondents No.6 to 9, who are extending threats to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) before respondent No.2, however, no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar, to decide the representation dated 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioners in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and also to provide security to the petitioner in case the same is required.
