1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the order dated 21.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) whereby the claim of the petitioner seeking employment on compassionate ground has been rejected.

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that instead of considering the claim of the petitioner for grant of compassionate appointment, his claim may be considered for grant of financial assistance of Rs.5,00,000/- as per the rules of the respondent-Mill.

3. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 submitted that he has no objection in case the aforesaid claim of the petitioner for



financial assistance is considered by the competent authority of the respondent-mill.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Managing Director of the respondent-Mill to consider the claim of the petitioner with regard to the compassionate assistance of Rs.5,00,000/- in accordance with law and by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from today.

5. At this stage, it has been pointed out by learned counsel appearing for the respondents-mill that there is a time period specified for considering the compassionate assistance as well. It is, therefore, also directed that while considering the case of the petitioner for grant of financial assistance, if already not given, the delay would not come in the way.
