Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that against the tentative seniority list, the petitioner had raised objection but, while finalizing the seniority list, not even a single objection has been dealt with which is causing prejudice to him. Learned counsel further submits that no reason has been given for rejecting the objection whereas, all the executive orders are to be self explanatory giving reasons for arriving at a particular conclusion.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Swapan Shorey, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-15) be treated as withdrawn with liberty to pass a



fresh speaking order giving the reasons in case, the authority concerned has not accepted the objection raised by the petitioner qua the tentative seniority list.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the impugned order dated 22.03.2024 (Annexure P-15) has been withdrawn with liberty to pass a fresh order, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
