In the present petition, prayer of the petitioner is that he has been dismissed from service on account of conviction by the criminal Court under Section 304-A of the IPC but the appeal against the said conviction is pending.

As per the respondents, even the appeal against the conviction has been dismissed as of now and once, the petitioner is a convicted employee, he cannot be allowed to continue in service especially, when the petitioner has been convicted under Section 304-A of the IPC, which reflect upon his moral.

No one appears on behalf of the petitioner to press the present petition.

The revision petition against the conviction is pending. In case, the petitioner succeeds in the revision petition qua the conviction, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy to seek appropriate relief.

Present petition is disposed of with above observations.
