MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.61 dated 18.04.2023 under Sections 379-B, 324 of the IPC (Sections 201, 411, 34 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has submitted that the matter stands amicably settled between the parties and they have also approached this Court for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of compromise by way of CRM-M No.34033 of 2024.

3. Mr. Amandeep Singh Jawandha, Advocate puts in appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant.

4. Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, on instructions, have not disputed the factum of



compromise having been arrived at between the parties. Learned counsel for the complainant has also not opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to enlarge him on regular bail.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the relevant material on record.

6. In the facts and circumstances as enumerated hereinabove, coupled with the fact that the matter already stands amicably settled between the parties, this Court deems it fit to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner. The petition as such is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
