GURBIR SINGH, J (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos. 4 & 5 and not to interfere in their personal lives.

2. It has been averred that petitioner No.1 is divorcee (judgment of divorce is annexed as Annexure P-7) and her date of birth is 15.11.1999 while petitioner No.2 is unmarried and his date of birth is 09.08.1992. Copies of Aadhar Cards of petitioner Nos.1 & 2 to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 and P-2.

3. It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 11.07.2024. The marriage certificate and marriage photographs are attached as Annexure P-3 & P-4. Respondent Nos. 4 & 5 had opposed to their marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated

18.07.2024 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of

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Police, Patiala seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 & 5.

4. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter and in particular the legality of the alleged relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to forthwith consider the aforesaid representation dated 18.07.2024 made on behalf of the petitioners and thereafter, take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners. Till then, protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. Respondent No.2 would pass necessary order without being influenced by any pleadings made in the petition.

7. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged relationship between the petitioners or protect them from legal action for violation, if any, committed by them.
