Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the official respondents to release the statutory benefits as enshrined under the SC/ST Act to the petitioner on account of her being a victim of atrocities as defined in the Act.

Learned State counsel has handed over today in Court a copy of the order No. 3266 dated 05.09.2024 passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, as per which claim of the petitioner for grant of financial assistance has been declined.

Since an order has been passed by the authorities declining the claim of the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the petitioner needs to challenge the said order, if so advised, in case the relief is required to be claimed.

The petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the available alternative remedies against the order No. 3266 dated 05.09.2024 passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala.
