The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.129 dated 14.03.2023 registered under Sections 408, 467, 468, 471, 120-B/34 IPC at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.09.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.09.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on
