The petitioner, by way of present contempt petition, seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents, alleging violation of order dated 11.02.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 3622 of 2017.

[2] Learned State counsel on instructions informs that the services of the petitioner have already been regularized and all consequential benefits including the refixation of pay as well as arrears alongwith interest shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of four weeks.

[3] In view of aforesaid assurance /undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[4] Disposed off as not pressed.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

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[6] It is made clear that in case the needful is not done, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition by instituting an appropriate application, and on the day of its listing, the officer concerned shall remain present in Court besides it, he / she shall bear the costs of Rs.50,000/- towards litigation expenses incurred by the petitioner from his / her own pocket.
