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Rajbir Sehrawat, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for wilful disobedience/defiance of the order dated 11.11.2022 passed by this Court in CWP 25647-2022.

At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as the necessary payments have been made by the respondents and only interest has not been paid. Counsel prays that the petitioner may be granted liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, in accordance with law.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
