1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that there is an anomaly between the pay of junior and the senior keeping in view of grant of ACP after 04, 09, 14 years, hence, the respondents are liable to remove the said anomaly by stepping up the pay of the seniors equivalent to the pay being drawn by juniors.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised through legal notice dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P/6), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.
3. Notice of motion.



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4. Mr. Arun Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, legal notice dated 15.04.2024 (Annexure P/6) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
7. Ordered accordingly.
