Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that as the petitioner No.2 has joined the service in the year 2017, present petition may kindly be disposed of as not pressed qua petitioner No.2

Ordered accordingly.

Qua the the petitioner No.1, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is working with the respondents since 16.05.1988 and is entitled for the grant of benefit of regularization of his services under the



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policy dated 01.10.2003.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the question of law raised in the present petition has already been decided by this Court while passing order in CWP-2158-2020 titled as Ashish Sharma and others vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 13.03.2024 along with other connected cases and present petition may kindly be disposed of in terms of the said order.

Learned counsel for the respondents does not dispute that the question of law raised in the present petition is covered by the decision of this Court in Ashish Sharma's case (supra).

Keeping in view the above, present petition qua petitioner No.1. is disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in Ashish Sharma's case (supra).
