The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.143 dated 31.05.2024 registered under Sections 147, 149, 120-B, 224, 225, 307, 341, 186, 332, 353, 393, 379-B and 511 IPC and Section 3 of the PDPP Act at Police Station Beri, Jhajjar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.07.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
