MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.88 dated 06.08.2021 under Sections 22, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') and Section 483 of the Cr.P.C. registered at Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla (earlier District Sangrur).

2. Learned State counsel at the outset has prayed for dismissal of the instant petition as recording of the prosecution evidence is complete and trial is at the fag end. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has submitted that even otherwise the petitioner does not deserve the concession of bail as a huge recovery of 4000 tablets of Radol-100-SR (Tramadol) was effected from him coupled with the fact that all the mandatory provisions of the NDPS Act were duly complied with at the time of making the alleged recovery.

3. In view of the instructions received by learned State

counsel, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.
