Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct fair and proper investigation in case bearing FIR No. 100 dated 03.04.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat and for getting the same investigated by some higher official.

Mr. Rahul Vats, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No. 4 and filed his power of attorney, which is taken on record.

Pursuant to notice of motion issued by this Court, reply dated 07.10.2023 has been filed by way of affidavit of Nar Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, City-1, Sonipat on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramesh submits that the Investigating Agency is investigating the matter fairly and properly by checking the veracity of each and every aspect.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the concerned Jurisdictional Magistrate and also the Investigating Officer and provide him the necessary details, facilitating proper investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any material is provided by the petitioner to the Investigating Officer, the same shall be taken into consideration while preparing the final report.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
