The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7 and to restrain the private respondents No.4 to 7 to not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with Jatinder Singh on 04.03.2013 and from this wedlock, two daughters were born. After the marriage of the petitioner the behaviour of her in-laws was not good towards her but after the birth of first daughter, their behaviour has changed and soon after the birth of second daughter, their cruelty has increased to the extent that are not bearable and the petitioner left her matrimonial home and came to her parental home. Thereafter, the private respondents and other relatives were forcing the petitioner to go back to her matrimonial home and to join the company of her

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husband but when the petitioner refused to adhere them and started living separately on a rented accommodation, the private respondents are advancing threats to the petitioner. Further, the petitioner has filed representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) in this regard to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, Punjab, but no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
