Present petition under Article 226/227 of Constitution has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of impugned order dated 14.07.2024 (P-4) vide which petitioners have been declared ineligible being overage; further issuance of writ in nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent-Commission to consider the petitioners as eligible and allow them to participate in the selection process.

(2) Short reply dated 29.07.2024 by Krishan Kumar, Deputy Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission-respondent No. 3 has been filed, which is taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

(3) After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file fresh with better particulars, including challenge to the Punjab Police Rules, 1934 (as applicable to the State of Haryana).
