Present second petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No. 362 dated 21.08.2021 under Sections 302, 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

(2) Learned counsel, on instructions, submits that at this stage instead of pressing the petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case, application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. pending before learned trial Court is decided expeditiously.

(3) In view of the above, this petition is disposed off with a request to learned trial Court to decide the application pending under Section 311 Cr.P.C on the date fixed or within four weeks thereafter, in case, there is no legal impediment.

(4) Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy before learned trial Court for seeking bail pending trial in accordance with law.

(5) It is clarified that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case in any manner.
