The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to appoint her on the post of Clerk in pursuance to the Advertisement dated 27.08.2016 (Annexure P-1) w.e.f. the date of appointment of similarly situated candidates, alongwith all consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for respondent nos.2 to 4 has filed additional affidavit dated 14.11.2023 of Shri Vikas Singh, Divisional Engineer (Establishment), Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation on behalf of respondent nos.2 to 4, which is taken on record, and in the said affidavit it has been stated that the petitioner has been offered appointment to the post of Clerk vide Appointment Letter dated 28.03.2023 (Annexure A-1), however, she has refused to join on the said post. He submits that since the relief of appointment, as claimed in the present petition, has already been offered to the petitioner and she has refused to join as such on the said post, therefore, the instant petition has become infructuous.
