VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing/modifying the order dated 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) and order dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-4).
2. Learned counsel for the private respondent has submitted that the petitioner has died and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the private respondent, present petition has been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to pursue the remedy before the civil Court in case they choose to do so.
4. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to pursue their rights if so advised before the civil Court.
